**DISCUSSION:**

This is a continuation of the project to revise and publish significant administrative requirements in the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration (ACJA) to make them readily available to judicial officers and employees throughout the state. There are five sections, all of which are new. We have included the previous administrative orders.

ACJA §§ 1-402, 1-801 and 5-109 may all be handled as consent items, unless any member wishes to discuss one or more of the sections separately.

ACJA § 6-114 may require explanation by staff and is expected to involve testimony in opposition to a specific recommended change.
