

The Search- *an Adoption Triad* Story*

Closed adoptions have been the norm for over five decades. Much has changed during that time. We now know that birth parents never forget their children who were placed for adoption, nor do adopted individuals stop wondering about their biological heritage. Adoptive parents have not been handed “blank slates”, but children who already possess a temperament and a genetic history. All three parties to the triad recognize the need to share medical information. For all of these reasons, and more, parties to closed adoptions have begun to search for one another. They are all impacted in different ways. This video is about that impact.
