


1 years of the effective date of suspension, she must submit to formal reinstatement
2 proceedings pursuant to Rule 65. To be reinstated, Applicant must cure the grounds upon
3 which the suspension order was entered by payment of the amount of fees, assessments and
4 any administrative costs.

5 The record reflects that Applicant has not practiced law since her suspension but has
6 worked in law related fields. Applicant resided in Texas from January 2003 to August 2005.
7 She completed Real Estate School in October 2007; however, Applicant has not worked
8 since November 2007, due to medical reasons.

9 The Hearing Officer found and the Commission agrees that Applicant has cured her
10 failure to pay dues, sufficiently resolved her medical issues, and she is now able to practice
11 law and recommends reinstatement.

3. Ms. Hansberry resided in Texas from January 2003 to August, 2005 (TR p. 20: 6-13; 30:19-20). When Applicant was in Texas, she did not practice law but did work in law related fields (Exb. 2).

4. When she returned to Arizona, Ms. Hansberry also worked in law related fields, but did not practice law. (TR p. 10 – 13, Exb. 2) . She attended Real Estate School in 2007 (TR 13: 21-22). She has not worked at all since November of 2007 due to medical issues. (TR: 14, 24, Exb. 2)

5. Applicant paid her Arizona Bar dues in December, 2008 and completed paying all unpaid Bar dues and reinstatement fees by March 12, 2009. (Motion for Reinstatement Exb. Q).

6. Applicant's medical issues are sufficiently resolved that she is able to resume the practice of law. (TR 20:9-16)

7. Applicant's suspension was not the result of any disciplinary process, she has now paid all of her back Bar dues, has no other issues such as CLE compliance, and the Bar does not oppose her reinstatement (TR 4:15-18)

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8. Applicant has now cured her failure to pay her Bar dues and there appear to be no legal or factual reasons precluding her reinstatement in good standing to the State Bar of Arizona.

RECOMMENDATION

9. This Hearing Officer finds that Applicant has satisfied her obligation to the Arizona State Bar, paid all her Bar dues arrearages, and recommends that she be readmitted to the Arizona State Bar.
