) ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT

Applicant **THOMAS C. PICCIOLI** has established to the satisfaction of the Disciplinary Commission and this Court that he is qualified for reinstatement to active bar membership; now, therefore, pursuant to Rule 65 of the Rules of the Supreme Court,

IT IS ORDERED that **THOMAS C. PICCIOLI** be and hereby is reinstated as a member of the State Bar of Arizona effective the date of this Order, and is placed on probation for a period of two years, under the terms and conditions as listed below:

1. Respondent shall contact the State Bar of Arizona's Member Assistance Program ("MAP") director or designee to participate in an evaluation. Respondent shall cooperate with any recommendations made by the MAP director or designee.
2. Respondent shall refrain from engaging in any conduct that would violate the Rules of Professional Conduct or other rules of the Supreme Court of Arizona.
3. In the event that Applicant fails to comply with any of the foregoing conditions, and the State Bar receives information, bar counsel shall file with the imposing entity a Notice of Non-Compliance, pursuant to Rule 60(a)(5), Ariz.R.Sup.Ct. The Hearing Officer shall conduct a hearing within thirty days after receipt of said notice, to determine whether the terms of probation have been violated and if an additional sanction should be imposed. In the event there is an allegation that any of these terms have been violated, the burden of proof shall be on the State Bar of Arizona to prove non-compliance by clear and convincing evidence.
