Supreme Court visits Navajo and Apache counties

PHOENIX – The Arizona Supreme Court will visit Apache and Navajo Counties as part of the strategic agenda “Good to Great” and connecting with communities. The Court will hold a town hall in Snowflake, Arizona and conduct Oral Arguments in Chinle, Arizona. This historic first trip is the first time the Court has held Oral Arguments in the Navajo Nation.

The town hall will take place from 12:30 to 1:30 p.m. on October 3, 2006, in the Snowflake High School Gymnasium, 682 School Bus Lane. The public is welcome, but seating is limited so please arrive early. Doors open at 11:45 a.m. Attendees are strongly encouraged to leave all electronic devices and bags at home.

The Court will hold Oral Arguments at 1 p.m. (MDST), 12 p.m. (MST) on October 4, 2006, at the Chinle Community Center, Mile Post 440 Hwy 191.

Students and community members from around the Navajo Nation and Apache County will be in attendance as the Court hears arguments in two cases:

- CV-06-0076-PR: George Winn v Plaza Healthcare
- CV-06-0008-PR: Suzanne Tyman v Hintz Concrete Inc

“It’s important for the judicial branch to reach out to all Arizona residents,” said Chief Justice Ruth V. McGregor. “We’re excited to bring this opportunity to Navajo and Apache counties, and look forward to hearing from its residents.”

The public is welcome, but seating is limited so please arrive early. Doors open at 11:30 a.m. Attendees are required to go through security screening, and are strongly encouraged to leave all electronic devices and bags at home.
