## **Arizona Judicial Branch Announces New Crime Victim Notification System**

Pursuant to a new law passed in the most recent legislative session, victims of crime can request the Arizona Supreme Court and Arizona Court of Appeals, Divisions One and Two notify them of an opinion or decision at the same time the prosecutor and defendant are notified.

Parties can make the request of any of the three appellate courts by completing a form located on any of the three Clerks of Court Websites:
