Applications Being Accepted for Vacancy on Arizona Court of Appeals

Applications are being accepted for a vacancy created on Division I of the Arizona Court of Appeals when Judge Susan Ehrlich retires on June 27. The Commission on Appellate Court Appointments will review applications, interview selected applicants and recommend at least three nominees to Governor Janet Napolitano.

Applicants must be at least 30 years of age, of good moral character, and admitted to the practice of law in and a resident of Arizona for the past five years. To be eligible an applicant must also have resided in Maricopa County for the past three years.

The original completed application and 17 copies must be returned to the Administrative Office of the Courts, Human Resources Division, 1501 W. Washington, Suite 221, Phoenix, AZ, 85007, by 3:00 p.m. on July 18, 2008. The Commission may, at its discretion, use the applications filed for this vacancy to nominate candidates for any additional vacancies known to the Commission before the screening meeting for the vacancy is held.

All meetings of the Commission on Appellate Court Appointments are open to the public. Meeting dates will be announced in July.

The new judge will be paid \$139,388 annually.
