County Supervisors appoint JP Judge

The Yuma County Board of Supervisors announced today the appointment of Greg Stewart as Judge for Yuma County Justice Court Precinct #1.

Stewart currently works for the Yuma County Adult Probation Department, where he has been employed as a Probation Services Supervisor since August 1994. He has served in various capacities in both Adult and Juvenile Probation since 1988.

Stewart is keenly involved in the coordination of the Yuma County Adult Drug Court Programs and has directed and coordinated all program activities. This involvement was instrumental in the program being presented the 2005 Justice for a Better Arizona Achievement Award.

Stewart earned his B.S. from Arizona State University in 1987 and Majored in Social & Behavioral Sciences.

Stewart will fill a vacancy occasioned by the untimely death of the Hon. David F. Cooper in December. The initial term of office is a provisional term of one year. Thereafter, if retained by the voters in November 2010, the term for a justice court judge is four years beginning January 2011.

The current annual salary for the position is \$101,450.
