ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION) No. 2000- 52

On January 6, 1998, by Administrative Order 98-1, Judge José Luis Castillo, a justice court member, was appointed to the Advisory Committee on Alternative Dispute Resolution with an expiration of his term of service ending on December 31, 2000. Judge Castillo is unable to fulfill his commitment to the committee and has resigned his appointment.

In accordance with Administrative Order No. 91-30, which established the Advisory Committee on Alternative Dispute Resolution, the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing members of the Committee. Upon recommendation and after due consideration,

IT IS ORDERED that Judge Carmen Dolny is appointed to the Advisory Committee on Alternative Dispute Resolution to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Judge José Luis Castillo and shall serve the remaining term beginning as of the date of this Order and ending December 31, 2000.
