ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
No. 83-12

The Board of Governors of the State Bar of Arizona having established membership fees of \$160.00 for active members who have been admitted to practice for over three years, \$125.00 for active members who have been admitted to practice for less than three years, of which amounts \$5.00 shall be an assessment for the Client Security Fund, and membership fees of \$30.00 for retired members, now therefore, in accordance with Rule 27(c), Rules of the Supreme Court of Arizona,

IT IS ORDERED that the fees and assessments established by the Board of Governors are approved.
