ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON RECORDS MANAGEMENT**

Administrative Order No. 88-1

In accordance with Administrative Order No. 87-17, the Chief Justice may appoint advisory committees of the Council on Judicial Administration to assist the Council in carrying out its responsibilities. In order to develop statewide standards and recommendations for the management, retention and destruction of court records,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. An Advisory Committee on Records Management is created to advise the Council on Judicial Administration on appropriate standards for records management in the superior court and courts inferior to the superior court.

2. The Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Records Management may appoint, as necessary, subcommittees and other working groups to assist the committee in carrying out its responsibilities.
