ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 96-53

A.R.S. §13-4041 mandates that the Supreme Court appoint counsel to represent indigent capital defendants in state post-conviction relief proceedings who meet certain statutory criteria. Additionally, subsection C mandates the Supreme Court, by January 1, 1997, to establish and maintain a list of qualified candidates. Further, in Supreme Court No. R-96-0030, the Court adopted Rule 6.8, Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure outlining minimum standards for appointment of counsel in capital cases. In order to establish a list of qualified candidates it is necessary to develop an application and solicit responses of qualified attorneys who may wish to be included on the list.

Now, therefore, in accordance with the authority granted the Supreme Court in AZ Const. Art. VI, Section 3, A.R.S. §13-4041 and Rule 6.8, Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure, it is ordered that the attached application form is adopted. Notice of the availability of the application forms will be made available by 1) publication in the Arizona Business Gazette, 2) publication in the Arizona Attorney, 3) publication in the Maricopa Lawyer, 4) publication in The Writ for Pima County, and 5) mailing to the following:

1. Arizona Association of Defense Counsel
2. Arizona Attorneys for Criminal Justice
3. All attorneys who are certified as Criminal Specialists
4. State Bar Section for Criminal Justice
5. Each president for the County Bar Associations
6. State Bar Appellate Practice Section
7. Presiding Judges
8. Speaker of the House of Representatives
9. President of the State Senate
10. Any other entity or individual deemed advisable by the Administrative Director of the Court.

The Administrative Director of the Court is delegated the responsibility and all powers necessary to adopt a procedure to reimburse the counties in accordance with the statute.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED this Administrative Order is effective immediately upon signature of this order.
