Administrative Order
No. 96- 63

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-4041 as amended effective July 18, 1996, the Supreme Court is to establish and maintain a list of qualified candidates eligible for appointment as counsel for indigent capital defendants in state post-conviction proceedings. By Administrative Order No. 96-53, filed November 19, 1996, the Court began implementing the provisions of the statute and Rule 6.8, Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure, which establishes standards for the competency of counsel in capital cases. The Court finds it advisable to appoint a committee to assist the Chief Justice in further implementing A.R.S. § 13-4041 and Rule 6.8. Therefore, pursuant to art. 6, § 3 of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the Committee on the Appointment of Counsel for Indigent Defendants in Capital Cases is established. Persons appointed to the Committee shall serve for three years, except that to ensure continuity, the terms of those appointed pursuant to this order shall expired as indicated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following persons are appointed to serve on the Committee for the terms specified:
